The proposed improvements consist of 68 SF of wing wall removal, 26 LF of Handrail and 130 LF of timber guardrail construction located in the Village of North Aurora in accordance with the Plans and Specifications as set forth in the Contract Documents.

The Village of North Aurora reserves the right to reject any and or all Bids, to waive any irregularities and informalities. Awards will be made to the lowest responsible Bidder as determined by the Village of North Aurora.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the Project shall apply to the contract throughout, including the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (Ill. Rev. Stat. Ch. 48, Sects 39s-1-12) and the Illinois Preference Act (Ill. Rev. Stat. Ch. 48, Sects. 2201-2207). Federal labor standards and prevailing wage rates will apply to portions of this project. Minorities and Women Owned Businesses (MBE/WBE) are encouraged to submit bids on this Project.
