VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING MINUTES MAY 15, 2017

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Berman called the meeting to order.

ROLL CALL

In attendance: Mayor Dale Berman, Trustee Mark Gaffino, Trustee Mike Lowery, Trustee Laura Curtis, Trustee Mark Carroll, Trustee Tao Martinez, Trustee Mark Guethle and Village Clerk Lori Murray.

DISCUSSION

1. Gerald Hyundai Economic Incentive Agreement

Mike Toth stated that Gerald Auto Group was seeking feedback regarding the incremental approach to the incentive agreement.

Gerald Auto Group requested the incremental amount, the additional amount of the sales tax that the Village receives in excess of that from a base year be rebated to the Gerald Auto Group over a period of twelve years. Based on projections by the auto group, they anticipate the maximum amount of \$1M would be reached in 11 years.

Trustee Curtis asked if Gerald Auto Group was seeking rebates from other entities such as the County and the State. Answer was no. Curtis asked if other towns such as Naperville do similar types of agreements. Village Administrator Steve Bosco said yes, adding that the Village has a history with the auto mall of giving incentives. The reason this is done is because the auto mall is one of the Village's biggest economic engines. Gerald did the new KIA dealership and redid the Subaru stand-alone dealership. They are also looking to expand their other dealerships.

Trustee Lowery asked if the Village would still be getting the benefit from the taxes based on the sales from the base year. Answer was yes. The Board was in favor of the concept being proposed.

Toth said that staff will continue to work with the Gerald Auto Group and will work on the baseline. Will also work with Attorney Drendel in drafting the economic incentive agreement.

2. PEG Access and Broadcasting Village Board meetings.

Steve Bosco stated that Staff put together a summary as well as options regarding moving forward with the Consortium and broadcasting Village meetings.

Funding: The Village receives 5% of its gross sales of Comcast. Of that 5% franchise fee, 40% goes to funding the Consortium.

Looking at years 2013, 2014 and 2015, the Village paid \$83,000 in fees and refunded \$42,000. The Consortium retained about \$41,000.

4 Options for the Board to consider

Option 1: Village stays in the Consortium and does not do anything differently but broadcast its meetings through them. The Consortium is able to broadcast on Comcast, AT&T, Metranet, live stream and can provide the meetings on YouTube. Cost to the Village would be \$41,000 - \$84,000. Residents would also be able to utilize the studio at Waubansee Community College.

Option 2: Village would not be a part of the Consortium. The Village would ask for a PEG channel. The start-up costs would be approximately \$33,000 the first year. The Village would also want to replace the character generation system every 7 years. There would be no access to the studio at Waubansee Community College.

Option 3: Village would video tape its own meetings via camera and post to YouTube. Cost for the camera would be approximately \$3,000. Camera would be placed in a fixed location. There would be no access to studio.

Option 4: The Village would have studio PEG access through the Consortium. The Village would stay in the Consortium, but only if the Village Board negotiates a rate for a fair number.

Trustee Carroll asked how the amount of the refund is determined each year. Mike Rennels of FVTV (Fox Valley TV) said that the amount was set by the Board at 50% of the contribution.

Rennels noted that since 2007, the Consortium has been refunding back 50% to each of the communities that are part of the Consortium. Rennels said that taping the village meetings would be a great step forward and the village would be missing out if it is not part of the Consortium since it is currently broadcasting meetings for the other communities within the Consortium. Rennels said that Yorkville is hooked up for livestream. Professional HD cameras are used and a camera operator is also present. The next day the tape is brought back to the studio and it is streamed live and aired twice a day, every day, the week after. Rennels also stated that the Consortium works closely with different programs and clubs in the Village such as the Mother's Club and Lion's Club.

Trustee Lowery asked if Rennels was aware of the viewership for the public access channel. Rennels said he hopes to get that information through their analytics.

Trustee Curtis said that the Board is in agreement about broadcasting the Village meetings, however, felt that the Village has been paying \$40,000 a year for years and didn't get anything in

return. Curtis said that when taking a look at the cost benefit analysis on the chart, the Village is looking at a 10-year expense of a half million to a million dollars versus other options to broadcast the same information.

Curtis said that it is not the municipalities' job to make public broadcasting education available to residents. There is funding through other taxable bodies. Curtis stated she cannot see spending half a million dollars and subsidizing these programs when we can achieve our goal which is making our meetings public, at a fraction of the cost. Rennels said there are numerous organizations that make use of this channel on a regular basis. Curtis said the village is a municipal entity and we are not supposed to be subsidizing the mothers club or the lions club which are non-profit and have their own way of generating their own revenue through donations.

Carroll said that if we can lower the cost, he sees a great benefit to the community. Gaffino said that the Village needs to be utilizing this service.

Guethle asked if the Consortium could provide a link for the recordings that are done so that it can be shared. Rennels said yes.

Mayor Berman said that it appears that the Board wants to continue in some capacity so will need to have something in writing to vote on.

3. Donation Bins

Code Enforcement has sited a property owner in town for having an unattended collection bin in town. The Village was approached by the attorney of the collection bin company stating that the village was unconstitutionally applying provisions to these collection bins since there are other establishments like Goodwill and Salvation Army that have the ability to provide advertisements on their locations and they should have the same provided to them on their box. There was discussion about allowing the container with a screening mechanism.

Gaffino said he did not want to change what the Village currently has in place.

Toth said he would work with Attorney Drendel to put together an agreement that would allow the bins in back of buildings with screening.

AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 14 day of June 2016 by and between the COUNTY OF KANE, a body politic and corporate, and the <u>Milage of Molth Aurora</u>, an Illinois municipal corporation.

WHEREAS, the County of Kane ("Kane County") is a body politic and corporate duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of North Aurora ("Municipality") is an Illinois municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, Kane County pursuant to the Animal Control Act, 510 ILCS 5/1 et seq. (the "Act") has certain rights, duties and obligations with respect to rabies control and registration of dogs and cats on a county-wide basis, and also has primary responsibility for animal control activities within unincorporated Kane County; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has the right, but not the obligation to control animal activities in its corporate limits, and has historically taken the primary responsibility for animal control activities within its corporate limits and desires to contract with the County to discharge these responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Kane County Board Ordinance 07-254, passed July 10, 2007, Kane County is ready, willing and able to contract with the municipalities of Kane County to provide them with animal control services, including but not limited to pick-up of animals running at large, sick or injured dogs and small, wild mammals such as skunks, raccoons, and bats and providing housing and adoption services for animals in its custody to the best of its ability at Kane County Animal Control, located at 4060 Keslinger Road, Geneva, IL, (the "Facility") the Kane County ; and

WHEREAS, the parties have a mutual interest in long term planning for animal control services in Kane County;; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and Section 3 of the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/3, units of local government are authorized and empowered to enter into agreements to obtain and share services and to exercise jointly or transfer any powers or functions not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Kane County Board has heretofore been authorized pursuant to Resolution <u>16-174</u> to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Municipality as herein provided;

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NOW, THERFORE the COUNTY OF KANE and the Mase for the Auror do hereby agree as follows:

<u>Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals.</u> The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Agreement are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. Pickup Service Provided. The Kane County Animal Control Department will provide pickup service for stray dogs found within the limits of the Municipality, and for pickup of animals from locations where a forcible entry and detainer action results in an eviction conducted by the Kane County Sheriff, and shall transport them to the Facility or another County designated animal shelter for a service fee to be paid to the County as provided in Section 5-49(a) of the Kane County Code.

Section 3. Complaint Calls – Response. The Kane County Animal Control Department will respond to complaint calls, as provided in Section 5-49(a) of the Kane County Code, from the Municipality's police department (or appropriate Municipal officials if no police department exists), for barking dogs, dogs running at large and sick or injured wildlife outside of a building or structure within the limits of the Municipality and shall transport them to the Facility or another County designated animal shelter. The service fee to be paid to the County shall be that shown on Exhibit A. Should the Kane County Animal Control Department face unexpected budgeting concerns rendering the services described herein impossible to provide at the fees described herein, upon formal written notice by the Kane County Animal Control Administrator, the parties may renegotiate the financial terms of this Agreement. If the parties are unable to reach an agreement as to such renegotiation, any party may cancel this Agreement upon 30 days' written notice.

<u>Section 4. Vicious or Dangerous Dogs.</u> The Kane County Animal Control Department shall cooperate with the police department of the Municipality in responding to complaints relating to vicious or dangerous dogs. All complaints and proceedings shall be handled as provided in Sections 15 and 15.2 of the Act.

Section 5. Invoices for Services. Kane County shall invoice the Municipality for services provided at the end of each month and the Municipality shall remit payment to Kane County in full within thirty (30) days. The County invoice shall, at a minimum, specify the dates of service, particulars regarding the animal serviced and the types of services rendered. The County shall retain the right to limit, suspend, or terminate services to the Municipality if it shall omit to pay any fees within sixty (60) days of receipt of the County's invoice therefore. All fees for services shall be deposited by the County as set forth in Resolution 06-330.

Section 6. Termination of prior Agreements; Waiver of Fees. Upon the effective date of this Agreement, any and all prior agreements between Kane County and the Municipality are hereby, terminated and abrogated.

<u>Section 7. Fees and Charges to Individual Owners.</u> Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to limit the right of Kane County or the municipality to increase or impose any fees or charges to individual owners as permitted or provided by law.

Section 8. Effective Date: Termination. This Agreement shall commence upon the affixing of the last signature of any officer required to sign this Agreement, which date shall be deemed the "Effective Date." This Agreement shall remain in full force and in effect until 4/30/17 with two one-year renewal options. The Municipality shall notify the county in writing, not less than 60 days prior to the expiration date, of its intent to exercise each renewal option.

<u>Section 9. Additional Agreement</u>. The Parties agree to meet to work towards a long term solution to the regional issues of animal control. To that end, the County will assist the Municipality cooperatively with Metro West to participate in developing a plan to meet specific anticipated demand for animal control services due to municipal growth. Failure by the Municipality to participate in good faith in said meetings shall be a breach of the terms of this agreement by the Municipality.

Section 10, Service Provision Subject to Shelter Capacity.

The County shall reserve 30% of the animal shelter capacity for the exclusive use of the County for provision of services to residents of unincorporated Kane County and for its use for provision of County-wide animal bite investigation services. If, at any time, in the opinion of the Kane County Animal Control Administrator, animals in the shelter from the Municipality and other municipal contract-holders constitute more than 60% but less than 70% of total shelter capacity, the Administrator shall notify the Municipality as provided for in Section 12 of this Agreement. If, at that time, in the opinion of the Kane County Animal Control Administrator, animals in the shelter from the Municipality and other municipal contract-holders has reached 70% of the total shelter capacity, the Administrator shall notify the Municipality that Animal Control services for new additional animals are being suspended and for what time period they shall be suspended to the Municipality and to all other municipal contract-holders. In the event of service suspension, the County shall work with the Municipality to identify and obtain animal control services from other service providers in the geographic area, but it shall be the sole responsibility of the Municipality to secure such services for its residents during the service suspension period, and the County shall have no obligation, responsibility or liability to the Municipality for animal control services except as provided by other applicable law. Animal Control services shall be reinstated when the Animal Control Administrator determines that the unused shelter capacity has exceeded 30% for two consecutive weeks.

Section 11. Indemnification. The Municipality shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Kane County and its officers, agents and employees of and from any and all claims, demands, suits at law or in equity, of any kind and manner, which in any way occur or arise in connection with Kane County's services or facilities provided pursuant to this Agreement, except as to claims of negligence, intentional, willful or wanton acts committed by the County and its officers agents and employees and/or to the extent prohibited by law or public policy. In the event of a claim being made by the County under this Section, the County shall be entitled to be defended by counsel of

its own choosing, and the Municipality shall pay any reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses incurred by the County in connection therewith.

<u>Section 12 Notices.</u> Any notices permitted or required to be given under this Agreement shall be deemed given if sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by personal delivery to the person to who it is addressed, to the following:

<u>Section 13 Severability.</u> If any provision, clause or section of this Agreement shall be ruled or held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then and in such event such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Agreement which can be given effect without such invalid provisions and to that end to provisions of this Agreement are Severable.

<u>Section 14 Entire Agreement of the Parties.</u> This Agreement, and any ordinances or resolutions incorporated herein by reference or by operation of law constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and no modifications by course of conduct or oral agreement shall be valid unless reduced to writing and duly adopted by the Kane County Board and the Municipality.

Section 15. Binding Effect: Successors' Assignment. This Agreement shall be binding upon the respective parties hereto, and their lawful successors in interest, except that Kane County shall not assign performance of this Agreement to another unit of local government without the written consent of the Municipality.

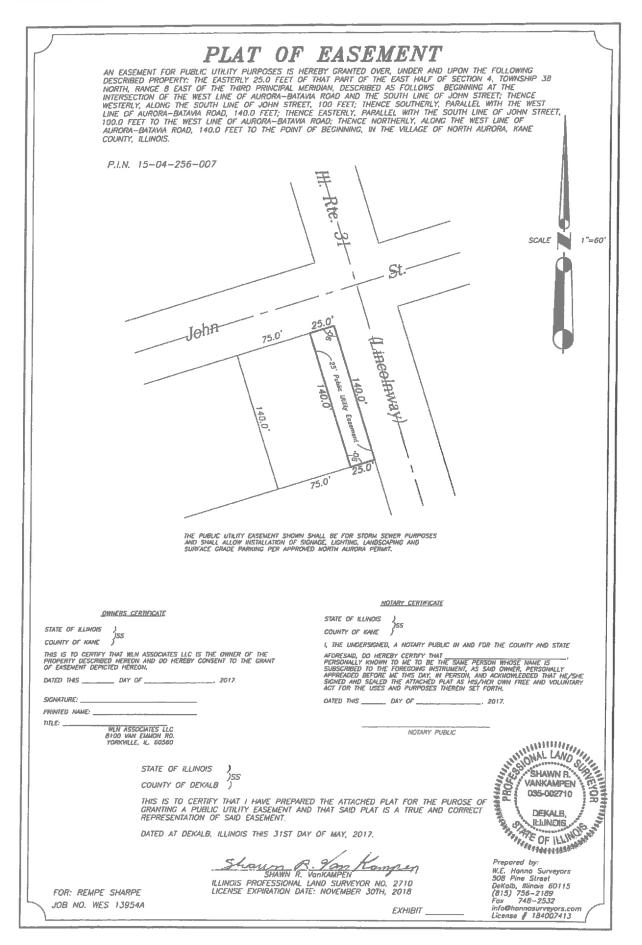

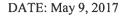

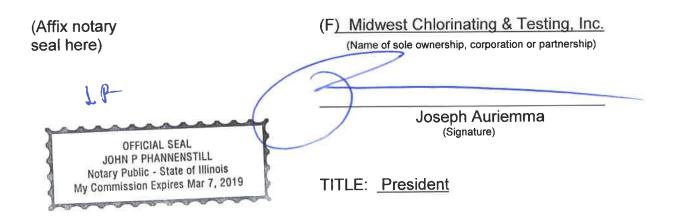

The project consists of removing and replacing 142 existing metal halide fixtures with LED fixtures and the replacement of 24 poles in poor condition. The Messenger Library has also partnered with the Village on this contract. An alternate base bid was requested to remove and replace 13 fixtures.

Construction documents for the project were prepared by Kluber Incorporated. The project was advertised and documents made available on April 5, 2017, a pre-bid meeting was held on April 19, 2017 and bids were received on May 2, 2017.

If the project is awarded at the June 5, 2017 Village Board meeting, it will begin in June after the new fiscal year begins. It is anticipated that substantial completion will occur in August of 2017 and the project will reach final closeout in September.

The results of the project letting can be seen in Table 1 below. The low bid for both the Village and the Library projects were submitted by Utility Dynamics Corporation. The Village had budgeted \$160,000 for this project in Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Re: BMP Towne Center Wetlands

The Village of North Aurora is required to make sure that the BMP Towne Center Wetlands are in compliance with the requirement of the Army Corps of Engineers. In order to generate the inspection reports necessary to document compliance, individuals with qualifications in environmental engineering and ecology need to evaluate the current condition of the wetlands.

The inspections that will be performed will determine if the wetland is functioning as it was originally designed. Recommendations will be prepared for any items that are identified as unsatisfactory. In addition to inspections, maintenance mowing is prescribed to control invasive annual and biennial species. Hey and Associates will conduct inspections for \$4,500 and perform maintenance mowing for \$15,500.

Staff would like approval for the Board to hire Hey and Associates to take over the wetland maintenance on the Village's behalf for the following reasons:

- Hey and Associates have extensive knowledge of the wetlands as they designed the maintenance program for the wetlands at their inception
- Hey and Associates have been working closely with the Army Corp of Engineers on their maintenance required since the wetlands were created
- The Village of North Aurora has worked with Hey and Associates on other projects and has been satisfied with their work

Per the attached agreement the first year cost for service for wetland maintenance will be \$20,000 and will be paid for out of the Special Service Area assessment that went into effect in 2016.

We are pleased to provide a proposal for continued management and monitoring services within the approximate 146 acre open space unit including the stormwater BMP basins located within the North Aurora Towne Centre Development property. We understand that there are no formal management or monitoring parameters that are required to be met for this project. Therefore, based on our regional experience and knowledge of the property, we propose the following scope of services:

BMP Inspection and Reporting

Hey will perform two site visits at the North Aurora Towne Centre site in 2017, spring and fall, to conduct inspections at each of the six stormwater BMP's. Each BMP will be assessed individually as to its functionality and current condition based on the design plans dated 5/16/2005. Individual inspection reports will be generated and will include a keyed site map, current photographs and any recommendations for items assessed as unsatisfactory and in need of attention. This task does not include any of actual maintenance work of the physical structures or infrastructure.

We will complete this task for a lump sum cost of \$4,500

Vegetation Management

Work in 2017 will build on progress made by our 2016 management efforts. Selective herbicide treatments will be used to treat invasive and undesirable weedy species throughout the natural areas communities. The focus will be on control of species such as common reed (*Phragmites australis*), reed canary grass (*Phalaris arundinacea*), purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*) in the wetland and field thistle (*Cirsium arvense*), crown vetch (*Coronilla varia*), teasel (*Dipsacus spp.*) and reed

canary grass in the upland community. The control efforts will be implemented to promote the functioning of the stormwater infrastructure system (inlets and outlets) to maintain proper flow. Observed minor debris jams will be cleaned.

Maintenance mowing may also be performed during the summer and early fall to control invasive annual and biennial species such as Queen Anne's lace (*Dancus carota*), sweet clover (*Melilotus* spp.), and sow thistle (*Sonchus* spp.). This task will include a meeting, if requested, with Village staff to discuss site maintenance issues and priorities. Activities in 2017 will be documented in a summary report, with recommendations for future maintenance activities.

We will complete this task for a lump sum cost of \$15,500

Any additional meetings or supplemental work would be in addition to the above amount or by separate proposal. Our Standard Terms and Conditions are attached.

EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into effective as of the 1st day of June, 2017, by and between the Village of North Aurora, State of Illinois, a municipal corporation, (hereinafter either "Employer" "Village" or "Village Board"), and Steven Bosco, (hereinafter "Employee"), both of who understand as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties, by this Agreement, to provide certain benefits, to establish certain conditions of employment, and to set working conditions of said Employee;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

SECTION 1: DUTIES

Employer hereby employs Employee as Village Administrator of the Village of North Aurora to perform functions and duties specified in the North Aurora Municipal Code Article II Chapter 2.12, and to perform other legally permissible and proper duties and functions as the Village Board shall from time to time assigns.

SECTION 2: TERM

Employee agrees to remain in the exclusive employ of Employer from June 1, 2017, through May 31, 2021 ("Term of Employment"), and neither to accept other employment nor to become employed by any other employer until said termination date, unless this Agreement is terminated as hereinafter provided or as specifically authorized by the Village Board.

SECTION 3: SUSPENSION

Employer may suspend the Employee with full pay and benefits at any time during the term of this Agreement by a vote of the majority of the Village Corporate Authorities.

SECTION 4: TERMINATION AND SEVERANCE PAY

- A. The Village may terminate the employment of Employee by directing written notice of termination to the Employee by regular and certified or registered mail. In the event Employee is terminated by the Board before expiration of the Term of Employment, and if Employee is willing and able to perform his duties under this Agreement, then in that event Employer agrees to pay Employee a lump sum cash payment equal to six (6) months' aggregate salary ("Severance Sum"). Employee shall also be compensated for all accrued benefits to which he is entitled.
- B. In the event the Employee resigns or is terminated for cause, as defined in the current Village Personnel and Policy Manual in effect at the time, including for conviction of a felony, illegal act or self-dealing at the expense of the Village, then Employer shall have no obligation to pay the Severance Sum.

C. In the event Employer at any time during the term of this Agreement reduces the salary of Employee, except in conjunction with an across-the-board reduction for all employees of Employer, then, in that event, Employee may, at his option, deem himself to be "terminated" by giving a sixty (60) day notice in writing within thirty (30) days of the decision to reduce his salary. The Employer may waive the notice period at its discretion.

SECTION 5: RESIGNATION

In the event Employee voluntarily resigns his position with Employer before expiration of the Term of Employment, then Employee shall give Employer sixty (60) days written notice directed to the Village President in advance if employee has taken a position as a Village Administrator in another community, otherwise Employee shall give Employer thirty (30) days written notice directed to the Village President. The Employer may waive the notice period at its discretion.

SECTION 6: DISABILITY

Disability shall be handled consistent with the Village Personnel and Policy Manual provisions in place for department heads.

SECTION 7: SALARY

Effective June 1, 2017, Employer agrees to pay Employee for his services rendered pursuant hereto an annual base salary of \$157,000.00, and Employer agrees to pay Employee additional compensation thereafter in the form of a bonus paid into his 457 Deferred Compensation Plan annually based on performance as determined by the Corporate Authorities. The bonus amount shall be determined according to the collective evaluation of the Corporate Authorities, based upon the four (4) point scale set forth in the Administrator Evaluation Form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, as follows:

If greater than 2 points the Employee shall receive a performance increase of \$1000;

If greater than 2.5 points the Employee shall receive a performance increase of \$2000; or

If greater than 3 points, the Employee shall receive a performance increase of \$3000.

Annual salary shall be payable in installments at the same time as the other management employees of the Employer are paid. Any service for a portion of a year shall be paid pro rata.

SECTION 8: PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

A. The Village Board shall review and evaluate the performance of the employee at least once annually in advance of the adoption of the annual operating budget. Said review and evaluation shall be in accordance with specific criteria developed in the Village Administrator Evaluation Form attached hereto as Exhibit A. Said criteria may be added to or deleted from as the Village Board may from time to time determine in consultation with the Employee. Further, the Village President shall provide the Employee with a summary written statement of the findings of the Village Board and provide an adequate opportunity for the Employee to discuss his evaluation with the Village Board upon request by the Employee within thirty (30) days of receipt of the performance review and evaluation.

B. Annually, the Village Board and Employee shall define such goals and performance objectives that they determine necessary for the proper operation of the Village and in the attainment of the Village Board's policy objectives and shall further establish a relative priority among those various goals and objectives, said goals and objectives to be reduced to writing. They shall generally be attainable within the time limitations as specified and the annual operating and capital budgets and appropriations provided.

SECTION 9: HOURS OF WORK

Employee agrees to devote his full-time efforts to this position and its responsibilities. Employee shall devote whatever time is necessary to fulfill his responsibilities as set forth in the Village Municipal Code Article II Chapter 2.12. The parties intend to create a salaried position, and the Employee's compensation is for the total services rendered and not for any specific number of hours. The Village President may award "comp time off", as provided in the Village Personnel and Policy Manual in effect at the time.

SECTION 10: OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES

Employee shall devote his primary efforts to the performance of his work for the Village. Employee shall not engage in any outside employment that will diminish his best efforts for and duties to the Village; nor shall Employee engage in outside employment that will create a conflict between the private interests of the Employee or outside employer and the Employee's official responsibility for the Village. Employee shall otherwise only engage in outside activities in compliance with the provisions of the Village Personnel and Policy Manual in effect at the time. Notice of such activities shall be given to the Village President.

SECTION 11: RESIDENCY

Employer shall agree not to require the Employee to have residence in the Village of North Aurora, Illinois.

SECTION 12: VACATION AND SICK LEAVE

- A. Employee shall accrue, and have credited to his personal account, four (4) weeks' vacation leave annually. Employee shall be entitled to payment for all accrued, but unused, vacation leave upon his leaving employment with the Employer.
- B. During the term of this Agreement, Employee shall accrue, and have credited to his personal account, sick leave at the same rate as other department heads of Employer as provided in the Village Personnel and Policy Manual in effect at the time. Employee shall be entitled to payment for all accrued, but unused, sick leave upon termination.

SECTION 13: HEALTH AND LIFE INSURANCE

The Village agrees to provide health insurance benefits for the Employee and his dependents in the same manner as is provided from time to time to other Village department heads as provided in the Village Personnel and Policy Manual in effect at the time.

SECTION 14: RETIREMENT

Employer agrees to make all Employer required payments, on behalf of Employee, related to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF).

SECTION 15: DUES AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

Employer agrees to budget for and to pay for professional dues and subscriptions of Employee necessary for his continuation and full participation in the International City/County Management Association (ICMA), the Illinois City/County Management Association (ILCMA), Illinois Municipal League (IML) and any other professional organizations, necessary and desirable for his continued professional participation growth, and advancement, and for the good of the Employer as approved by the Village Board.

SECTION 16: PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- A. Employer hereby agrees to budget for and to pay for travel and subsistence expenses of Employee for a reasonable number of professional and official travel, meetings, and occasions adequate to continue the professional development of Employee and to adequately pursue necessary official functions for Employer, including but not limited to the ICMA Annual Conference, ILCMA Conferences, and such other national, regional, state, and local governmental groups and committees thereof which Employee serves as a member up to a maximum of nine (9) days or seventy two (72) hours a year. Attendance, beyond the meetings specified above, shall be subject to prior Village Board approval.
- B. The Village recognizes that certain job-related expenses are incurred by the Employee and agrees to pay or reimburse such reasonable and necessary expenses as approved by the Village Board.

SECTION 17: INDEMNIFICATION

In addition to that required under state and local law, Employer shall defend, save harmless, and indemnify Employee against any tort, professional liability claim or demand or other legal action, whether groundless or otherwise, arising out of an alleged act or omission occurring in the performance of Employee's duties as Village Administrator, except that the Village shall not be liable to defend, safe harmless, and indemnify the Employee against any willful or wanton misconduct. Employer may compromise and settle any such claim or suit and pay the amount of any settlement or judgment rendered thereon.

SECTION 18: BONDING

Employer shall bear the full cost of any fidelity or other bonds required of the Employee under any law or ordinance.

SECTION 10: OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- A. The Village Board, in consultation with the Administrator, may establish such other terms and conditions of employment, as it may determine from time to time, relating to the performance of Employee, provided such terms and conditions are not inconsistent with or in conflict with the provisions of this Agreement, the Village, Illinois charter or any other law.
- B. All provisions of the Village, Illinois charter and code, and regulations and rules of the Employer relating to vacation, sick leave, retirement and pension system contributions, holidays, and other benefits and working conditions as they now exist or hereafter may be amended, also shall apply to Employee as they would to other employees of Employer, in addition to said benefits enumerated specifically for the benefit of Employee, except as herein provided.
- C. Employee shall be entitled to receive the same personal and sick leave benefits as are accorded department heads, including provisions governing accrual and payment therefore on termination of employment, except as provided herein.

SECTION 20: NOTICES

Notices pursuant to this Agreement unless specified otherwise herein, shall be given by deposit in the custody of the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

(2) EMPLOYEE: Steven Bosco

Alternatively, notices required pursuant to this Agreement may be personally served in the same manner as is applicable to civil judicial practice. Notice shall be deemed given as of the date of personal service or as of the date of deposit of such written notice in the course of transmission in the United States Postal Service.

SECTION 21: GENERAL PROVISIONS

A. The text herein constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties, and this text shall not be altered by any prior oral or written understanding.

- B. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs at law and executors of Employee.
- C. This Agreement shall become effective commencing June 1, 2017, and hereby supersedes and replaces all prior employment Agreements and understandings between the parties.
- D. If any provision, or any portion thereof, contained in this Agreement is held unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or portion thereof, shall be deemed severable, shall not be affected, and shall remain in full force and effect.
- E. Except as specifically modified herein, all provisions of the Village of North Aurora Personnel Policy Manual and all other employee regulations shall apply to the Employment of Employee herein.
- F. This Agreement may not be changed orally. All modifications of this Agreement must be in writing and must be signed by each party hereto.
