The Village welcomes residents to use enclosed burning devices instead, like a fire pit.

Temporary Weekly Free Bulk Item Pick-Up Program

As you may know, Waste Management postponed the Spring Clean-Up due to COVID-19 safety concerns. However, Waste Management is now offering an alternative program so residents can still dispose of bulk items for **free**.

Starting Friday, June 19, and going through the Fall Clean-Up date (September 18 and September 19), Waste Management is offering the following options for North Aurora residents:

• **Sticker customers** – (1) bulk item **OR** (1) additional refuse container per week with no sticker required (the first refuse container must have a sticker)

• Flat rate cart customers – (1) bulk item **OR** (1) additional refuse container per week with no sticker required

Because this program was made to replace the Spring Clean-Up, it does **not** include yard waste bags. No electronics (unless they are acceptable white good items) will be accepted either.

Increased Traffic During School Year

The bus driver will flash the lights on the front and rear of the bus and the stop signal arm will be extended. Please remain stopped until the lights and stop signal are turned off.

Help Reduce Storm Water Pollution

Water pollution prevention and control measures are critical to improving our water quality and reducing the need for costly wastewater and drinking water treatment. Water pollution can come from storm water runoff, which occurs when precipitation from rain or snowmelt flows over driveways, sidewalks and streets. Storm water runoff can pick up debris, chemicals, dirt and other pollutants and flow into the storm sewer system and then into our rivers, ponds, and wetlands. When water becomes polluted, the effects can be far reaching including creating unsafe drinking water.

Residents can help prevent storm water pollution by taking action and following the pollution prevention tips below:

- Keep litter, pet waste, leaves and debris out of street gutters and storm drains.
- Apply lawn and garden chemicals sparingly and according to directions.
- Dispose of used oil, antifreeze, paints and other household chemicals properly; not in storm sewers or drains.

At this time, the annual FREE Fall Clean-Up day is scheduled for the West side of the river on Friday, September 18 and the East side of the river for Saturday, September 19. Please have items out by 7 a.m. All non-hazardous bulk trash items will be picked up for free. Stickers are required for all regular household garbage and yard waste, which will be picked up on the same day as the clean-up schedule.
