Village President's Report - Dale Berman

Fall is a great time to spruce up your yard by raking leaves for the annual leaf pick-up, cleaning out flower beds and trimming bushes. In addition, please take time to trim any low hanging or broken tree branches on your property, that may overhang the public sidewalk. For parkway trees that need trimming, please call the Village Hall at 630-897-8228, x260. Trimming your trees will keep yards looking well-manicured, alleviate branches from obstructing the sidewalks and provide a safe pedestrian environment in your neighborhood.



The Federal Highway Administration defines the standards required to install and maintain traffic control devices on all public streets, including street signs. The Village's current red street signs are no longer in compliance with these standards. To be in compliance, the Village has recently bid for the purchase of new street signs, which will be blue with white lettering and will also incorporate the new Village logo. These new street signs will be a great enhancement to our neighborhoods and to the Village.

The Village has had a number of new businesses open recently, including Bulldog Ale House located at 459 N. Randall Rd; OMG Oh My Gyros at 352 N. Randall Road; and Vietnam Gate restaurant at 321 S. 2015 Free Leaf Pick-up Program

FREE curb-side leaf pick-up will run from mid-October through late November based on the schedule below.

Residents living on the WEST side of the River, pick-up will begin on Mondays the week of:

October 19, November 2 and November 16

Residents living on the EAST side of the River, pick-up will begin on Mondays the week of: October 26. November 9 and November 23



Leaf piles must be free of any foreign materials including branches, plants, rocks and landscape waste. Leaves should be raked in a row parallel to the street, at least 1 foot and no more than 5 feet back from the curb, and should be less than 2 feet in height. Leaves MUST be out at the curb by 6 a.m. on Monday of the pick-up week; however, leaves may be picked up at any time during that entire week. A daily log is kept of streets that have been serviced and trucks will not be able to go back down streets that have already been serviced. Please keep leaves away from mailboxes, pipes, ditches and culverts. Residents are encouraged to park in driveways or garages, and not on the street in front of leaf piles. Please note, snow, freezing temperatures, rain, and/or mechanical difficulties may delay or halt curbside leaf collection. Leaf-filled Kraft paper bags are picked up free, no stickers required, on Fridays during both October and November. All other landscape waste will require a sticker. The last pick up for leaves and landscape waste (sticker required) will be the last Friday in November. Please call Waste Management at 800-796-9696 or contact the Village Hall for further information or any questions.

Mailboxes - Please be sure your mailbox is in good repair and is sturdy enough to uphold the pressure of snow coming off the plow prior to our upcoming winter season. Make any needed repairs now.
