Re: Award of a contract to STF d.b.a. Traffic Control Company for Pavement Striping in the amount of \$22,374.64

The pavement striping program will place new thermoplastic pavement markings over existing markings. The purpose of this program is to make the lanes lines, turn arrows, and edge lines more vibrant against the pavement to clearly provide direction to motorists travelling the road network. The locations for the pavement striping are displayed in the table below. This year's program focused on arterial streets and the railroad crossings. The arterial streets see higher volume of traffic and higher speeds. It is important to have clear pavement striping at higher speeds. Clear striping also communicates the safe stopping distances at Railroad Crossings.

The results of the letting are summarized in the bid tabulation tables below. The low bidder was STF d.b.a. Traffic Control Company in the amount of \$22,374.64. Sufficient funding is available for this project from the Motor Fuel Tax fund.

Based on the satisfactory results of the references checked, it is the staff recommendation to award the pavement striping contract to STF d.b.a. Traffic Control Company amount of \$22,374.64.
