Garbage Sticker Exchange and Buyback Program

As a reminder, Village residents can use Waste Management stickers for their garbage and yard waste pick-up through <u>Wednesday</u>, June 23 with the Village's new waste hauler, Groot.

Should residents still have additional stickers on hand, the Village will be conducting a sticker exchange and buyback program from June 21 – June 30. Residents can bring unused Waste Management stickers to Village Hall (25 East State Street, open Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) to either <u>exchange</u> them one-for-one for Groot stickers or be <u>reimbursed</u> the Waste Management rate of \$4.03 per sticker.

STICKERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER JUNE 30.

Code Enforcement Reminders		Village of North Aurora Watering Restrictions
 Bulk items marked for disposal cannot be stored outside in public view. Please store these items inside garages, sheds or the house so as not to be readily visible to the public. Trash cans also cannot be stored in a front or corner side yard. Trash cans and lawn waste bags should not be placed at the curb until 3 p.m. the day before trash pickup, and such containers must be removed from the curb no later than midnight of the day of collection. 		Residents are reminded of the Village's watering restrictions, which allows for automatic watering and lawn sprinkling from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. limited to the following: All properties with even-numbered street addresses may water on even-numbered days of the month; and all prop- erties with odd-numbered street addresses may water on odd-numbered days of the month. The Village of North Aurora's watering restrictions are in place as a continual water conservation measure within the Village.
• Do not block the street or sidewalk with anything, in- cluding basketball hoops, toys, landscape materials, or poorly parked vehicles.	ŀ	Residents can use hand-held watering devices at any time. Watering restrictions are solely for automatic watering and sprinkling systems.
• Vehicles are not allowed to park on the grass. Campers, boats or other RV's can be parked on front drives Friday noon through Monday noon only.	, i (Not following the Village's watering restrictions may result in the following fines: Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense; one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the second offense; Not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars
• Lawns must be kept under 8 " in height. This includes weeds.	((\$750.00) for any subsequent offense. Each day a violation occurs will be considered a separate violation.

Holiday Garbage Pick-Up

Due to the 4th of July Holiday falling on Sunday this year, Groot will be closed on Monday. Garbage pick-up will be delayed one day. Please have items out by 6 a.m.

Street Infrastructure Projects – Residents can check the Village website at www.northaurora.org for updates on any current road and water construction projects that are ongoing within the Village.

Village Mosquito Spraying has begun throughout the Village to help prevent new breeding sites. Each month the Village will have an **entire application done during the evening hours** as well as treatments of all catch basins and ponds. To report high volumes of mosquitoes or to find out the last time your neighborhood was serviced, please call the Clarke Mosquito Hotline at 1-800-942-2555.

Street Lighting - Report streetlight outages to the Public Works Department. Street lights on wood poles are repaired by ComEd and can be called into the Village or to ComEd at 1-800-334-7661. Repair Services wait until they have a handful of calls before they come to service the area so please contact the Village Hall as soon as one goes out.

Sanitary Sewer - Call the Village **FIRST** if you should ever experience a sanitary sewer back up in your home. This will enable the Public Works Department to check the main sewer line for any trouble prior to residents calling a plumber. Calls after hours/weekends should go to the Police Department at 630-897-8705 where they will have someone paged.

Sewer Assistance Grant - The Village offers an overhead sewer assistance grant for residents who have a history of any sanitary backups. Please contact Public Works at 630-897-8228 x260 for any questions or information.

FREE Mulch is available at 316 Butterfield Road. Mulch is available to residents on a first come first serve basis. Please note, all mulch will need to be picked up and loaded by the resident, as delivery of mulch is not available.
