Public Works Director Richter explained that Water Division staff performed an inventory of old and used pumps to see if they were able to be reused. Staff dropped them off at Apex Industries to get them inspected and quotes for repairs. They could not be repaired meeting manufacturer specification, therefore the Village would like to purchase two new spare HMO pumps. One for each treatment plant.

As well as a new transfer pump. LAI, Ltd. is a sole source provider for these pumps, staff was recommending the purchase of two HMO pumps and the transfer pump from them.

## VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING MINUTES Monday, April 1, 2024

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Gaffino called the meeting to order.

#### **ROLL CALL**

#### **DISCUSSION**

#### 1. 2024-2025 Strategic Plan

Administrator Bosco explained that the Village Trustees and staff attended a workshop in January to update the Village's Strategic Plan. The evening's agenda item was to go through the revised draft. Bosco stated that he would do that by going through the plan, goal by goal and highlight some action steps and objectives that were new.

The first item Administrator Bosco addressed was the new objective of continuing to identify ways to promote the community's identity. The Action Plan for this included identifying areas to display new banners throughout the community, continuing to incorporate the Village's logo and tagline where appropriate, and creating a new police patch as well as identifying places to display the patch in marketing efforts. This also could include placement on new squad cars.

Bosco spoke about the ongoing issue of establishing a dog park in the community. He stated that the Village has the presence of three different park districts, including the Fox Valley Park District as well as the Batavia and Sugar Grove Park Districts. The action plan was to continue working with the park districts to establish a dog park. The Fox Valley Park District had indicated that they would like to move forward with a dog park soon. They had already started preliminary site visits of locations they view as viable.

The next goal Bosco spoke about was economic development. He stated that one of the Village's new objectives was to foster growth on vacant properties, subdivision and future annexed lands. With the creation of a new Economic Development position, the Village was drafting a completely new strategy on how it looks at economic development. The Village was looking at marketing vacant properties and working with residential developers to complete unfinished and undeveloped subdivisions. The Village also plans on focusing on future annexed lands which includes areas where boundary line agreements established in recent years with Aurora, Sugar Grove and Batavia.

Another objective under the Economic Growth goal was to facilitate economic and business development activities. This included the action plan to create an Economic Development Plan that incorporates incentive policies, marketing properties and ways to enhance development. Bosco explained that this

Economic Development Plan will take into account the feedback given by the Village Board in regard to what they see as appropriate for the community.

The next goal was Efficient and Effective Delivery of Core Services. One of the new objectives within this goal was to continue efforts to attract and retain employees. Bosco explained that the Village Board had already put forth effort to make the Village more competitive in regard to wages and benefits. Another objective within this goal was to enhance resident communication options and methods to improve information distribution channels internally and externally for Village services and activities. Bosco stated that this was not exclusive to social media, this also addressed the way the Village operates with residents. The Village would be seeking to automate more things and become easier for residents to navigate necessary interactions, such as permitting and payments.

Bosco also mentioned the initiative to construct a new community informational sign in a more centralized location.

Under the goal of continue maintenance and capital resource planning for village infrastructure, and the objective of stabilizing existing water supply and storage, the action item was updated to eliminate the 750,000 gallon aspect of a third water storage tower due to the multiple changes in the proposed water tanks capacity. It will now read "build a third water storage tower", because staff knows that the Village will need a third tower regardless of size. A million gallon tower was currently being designed, however the capacity could go up to 1.25 million.

The final goal Administrator Bosco spoke about was revitalizing the Route 31 corridor and creating a community focal point. He spoke about the efforts made to create a community place of gathering along the riverfront. In an effort to drive that, the objective of exploring redevelopment options to create a focal point of the Route 31 corridor between John and Oak Streets and between Route 31 and Route 25 was created. Bosco spoke about TIF funding and creative ways to make the action plan items such as burying power lines and creating pedestrian friendly accommodations happen.

An additional objective was to evaluate the removal of the Fox River Dam. The Village had been working with the IDNR for several years on the potential of removing the dam, with each step of the process taking several months. Bosco explained how the process had been and how he anticipates it will be moving forward involving the residents and the Fox Valley Park district who owns the shoreline along the river, to ensure a restoration plan should the dam be removed.

Under the same goal regarding the revitalizing of the Route 31 corridor, Administrator Bosco spoke about an action item of the Village to explore opportunities to acquire properties that may be available but do not necessarily have a good redevelopment reuse to create parking opportunities along the river, the Village's focal point.

Bosco then spoke about the roads throughout the focal point, Routes 31, 56 and 25 being state roads and being under the jurisdiction of IDOT. The action items of evaluating possible road reconfiguration on Route 31 to address lane width, evaluating safety options for State Street, as well as maintenance and infrastructure issues are subject to IDOT approval.

The Village Board expressed approval of amendments and additions to the Strategic Plan.

Mayor Gaffino spoke about making improvements to the Village's Veterans Memorial. He suggested forming a committee to make suggestions for enhancements to the site.

There was discussion regarding the addition of signage at Oak and Willow Way as well as John St and Route 31 to alert people of the memorial. There was concern expressed about the number of unrelated signs at the corner of Oak and Willow Way and the suggestion that the messaging might be lost. Administrator Bosco spoke about adding a placeholder for enhancements into the upcoming budget review. He also suggested adding an objective or action step to the Strategic Plan under the Community Vitality goal, to make enhancing the Veterans Memorial a goal for the Village Board.

The Village Board was in agreement to add the item to the Strategic Plan.

Administrator Bosco suggested a social media marketing campaign to alert residents of the Veterans Memorial and increase interest in the park.

Mayor Gaffino suggested involving Teska in the enhancement of the park. Administrator Bosco suggested adding the action item of working with landscape design architect on a concept for updating the Veterans Memorial.

Administrator Bosco spoke about the Lions Club's efforts to acquire a piece of decommissioned military equipment for the park.

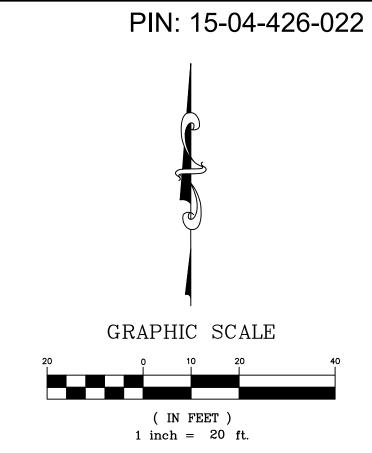

**Purchases** 

The Village of North Aurora utilizes the Central Managements Services (CMS), which is operated by the State of Illinois, for the bidding process to procure rock salt. They have changed their process when it comes to the bidding process several times over the past ten (10) years. This year they are requiring all municipalities to submit a Certificate of Authority which will give authority to designated Village staff to request a bid for rock salt. Attached is the Certificate of Authority by vote for you to review.

For the winter of 2021-22 we ordered and took 3,000 tons of salt and the winter of 2022-23 we order and accepted 3,000 tons of salt. This winter we ordered less salt, 2,600 tons. We will only take 80% of this which is around 2,000 tons. We like to start out the winter season with our salt dome domes full which is around 2,200-2,400 tons. We currently have approximately 2,800-3,000 tons of salt stored in our two salt domes. We created extra outdoor storage for salt at the eastside salt dome and this area will be covered by large tarps to protect the salt from the elements. We have had two below normal winters in a row which has left us with extra salt. With this large amount of salt currently on hand, we will be significantly decreasing our salt order to around 400-800 tons for 2024-25 winter season.

Staff is recommending authorizing Brian Richter, Public Works Director, Brandon Tonarelli, Assistant Public Works Director/Village Engineer, and Todd Murphy, Street Department Foreman to be designated to submit a bid request to the State of Illinois for rock salt.

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# A RESOLUTION TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE EXCHANGE OF REAL PROPERTY BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA AND THE SOUTHERN KANE COUNTY TRAINING ASSOCIATION AND TO SET A HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, the Southern Kane County Training Association (SKCTA) owns property commonly known as 300 Butterfield Road, North Aurora, IL 60542, on which it operates for nonprofit purposes a regional center for local governmental entities in fire, EMS, and disaster training that is legally described in Exhibit A to this Agreement (SKCTA Property), the Village desires to acquire a portion of the SKCTA Property legally described in Exhibit B to this Agreement for the purpose of building and operating a new public works facility (the "SKCTA Transfer Parcels"); and

WHEREAS, the Village owns property immediately adjacent and to the east of the SKCTA Property commonly known as 314 and 318 Butterfield Road, North Aurora, IL 60542, on which it currently operates it public works facility that is legally described in Exhibit C to this Agreement (Village Property), and the SKCTA desires to acquire a portion of the Village Property legally described in Exhibit D to this Agreement for the purpose of operating an indoor training facility with office and storage functions within the current Village public works building (the "Village Transfer Parcels"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has authority under Section 11-76.2-1 et seq. of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76.2-1 et seq.) to exchange the Village Property for the SKCTA Property under terms and conditions that are in the long-term best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated the terms of an agreement for the exchange of the Village Transfer Parcels for the SKCTA Transfer Parcels that are proposed in the Agreement for the Exchange of Real Property between the Village of North Aurora and the Southern Kane County Training Association dated November 7, 2022, as amended and attached hereto as Exhibit "E" (the "Agreement" or the "Proposal").

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Aurora, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are adopted and incorporated herein as the material and significant findings of the President and the Board of Trustees as if fully stated herein.
- 2. The Proposal shall be considered at a public hearing hereby scheduled for the regularly scheduled Village Board meeting on May 6, 2024, with legal notice published as required by Section 11-76.2-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code for the approval of exchange of real estate (65 ILCS 511-76.2-1).

Staff stated that the timing of the strategic plan approval and proposed budget approval processes coincide, and that staff can present an updated strategic plan with an objective specific to the Veterans Memorial and in turn, include funding for possible Veterans Memorial project(s) in the upcoming fiscal year. Below is a summary of the objective and actions steps for the Veterans Memorial that were added. The Veterans Memorial objective is placed under the goal, "Community Vitality".

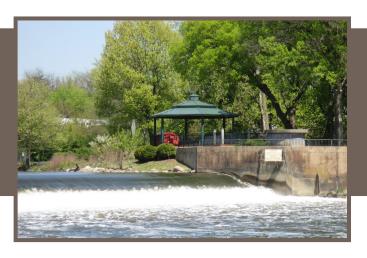

**RE:** Non-Home Rule Sales Tax Increase

At the December 18, 2023 Village Board meeting, the Board approved a resolution authorizing a referendum question to increase the Village's non-home rule sales tax to appear on the March 19, 2024 ballot. The referendum has officially passed with 1,162 yes votes to 961 no votes.

The attached ordinance increases the Village's non-home rule retailers' occupation tax and non-home rule service occupation tax (non-home rule sales tax) from 0.5% to 1.0% effective July 1, 2024. This will increase the Village's general sales tax rate from 7.5% to 8.0%. The ordinance, along with the certified election results, needs to be sent to the Illinois Department of Revenue by May 1, 2024 in order for the tax to be effective on July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Village will start receiving the additional tax revenue beginning in October 2024. The additional revenue will be recorded in the Capital Projects Fund will be utilized to fund future capital projects.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.16 - MUNICIPAL RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX AND CHAPTER 3.20 - MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA MUNICIPAL CODE

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, a non-home rule municipality may impose a municipal retailers occupation tax and a municipal service occupation tax upon approval of the electors of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS,** the electors of the Village of North Aurora (the Village) approved a 1/2 of 1% municipal retailers occupation tax and a municipal service occupation tax in the Spring of 2003 (the Tax); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees (the Board) has determined a need exists to increase the Tax; and

**WHEREAS,** the question as to whether to increase the tax from 1/2 of 1% to 1% has been submitted to the electors of the Village by referendum, and the electors have approved the imposition of the tax; and

**WHEREAS,** the tax is necessary for expenditures on public infrastructure, municipal operations, and/or property tax relief;

**WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Aurora, Kane County, Illinois as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Municipal Service Occupation Tax provisions codified in Chapter 3.16 Sections 3.16.010 through 3.16.040 are hereby repealed.
- **Section 2.** The Municipal Retailers Occupation Tax provisions codified in Chapter 3.20 Sections 3.20.010 through 3.20.040 are hereby repealed.
- **Section 3.** Chapter 3.16 of the North Aurora Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following provisions superseding and in place of the provisions repealed above:

#### **Chapter 3.16 Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax**

#### **3.16.010 Tax Imposed**

A tax is imposed upon all persons engaged in the business of selling tangible personal property at retail within the Village in the amount of one percent (1.0%) of the gross receipts from such sales made in the course of such business in accordance with the provisions of the Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax Act (Section 8-11-1.3 of the Illinois Municipal Code), as amended.

#### 3.16.020 Periodic Reports

Every such person engaged in such business in the Village shall file, on or before the time specified in such act as amended, the periodical report to the State Department of Revenue required by such act of such person, with reference to each period of time for which such a report is required and during which such person is so engaged, setting forth such information as may be required by such act, plus such additional information, if any, as may be pertinent to the tax imposed hereunder.

#### **3.16.030 Tax Payment**

All persons subject to the Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax shall pay such tax to the State Department of Revenue in compliance with the provisions of Section 8-11-1.3 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3), as amended.

**Section 4.** Chapter 3.20 of the North Aurora Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following provisions superseding and in place of the provisions repealed above:

#### **Chapter 3.20 Municipal Service Occupation Tax**

#### **3.20.010 Tax Imposed**

A tax is imposed upon all persons in the Village engaged in the business of making sales of service in the amount of one percent (1.0%) of the selling price of all tangible personal property transferred by such servicemen, either in the form of tangible personal property or in the form of real estate, as an incident to a sale of service in accordance with the provisions of the Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax (Section 8-11-1.4 of the Illinois Municipal Code), as amended.

#### 3.20.020 Periodic Reports

Every such person engaged in such business in the Village shall file, on or before the time specified in such act as amended, the periodical report to the State Department of Revenue required by such act of such person, with reference to each period of time for which such a report is required and during which such person is so engaged, setting forth such information as may be required by such act, plus such additional information, if any, as may be pertinent to the tax imposed hereunder.

#### **3.20.030** Tax Payment

All persons subject to the Service Occupation Tax shall pay such tax to the State Department of Revenue in compliance with the provisions of Section 8-11-1.4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4), as amended.

**Section 5.** The Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax established in Chapter 3.16 of The North Aurora Municipal Code and the Service Occupation Tax established in Chapter 3.20 of the North Aurora Municipal Code are established, imposed, and shall be collected for the purpose of funding expenditures on public improvements and infrastructure, municipal operations, and/or property tax relief as defined in Section 8-11-1.2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.2).

**Section 6.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to transmit to the State Department of Revenue a certified copy of this Ordinance no later than May 1, 2024, in order for the Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and the Service Occupation Tax imposed by this Ordinance to be collected by the State Department of Revenue beginning on July 1, 2024.

**Section 7.** This Ordinance shall take immediate full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and such other acts as required by law.

**RE:** Water Rate Increase Effective June 1, 2024

At the January 16, 2023 Committee of the Whole meeting, a presentation was given highlighting a 5-year projection of the Water Fund and the need to raise additional revenue. The increase in water rates is due to increasing operational expenses, as well as funding future capital projects.

The staff recommendation included a 50% water rate increase that would be phased over five years. The \$16 bi-monthly minimum charge for the first 3,000 gallons billed remains unchanged. The projected five-year rate model presented was:

Effective June 1, 2024, staff is proposing a 12.5% increase to water rates. This would increase the per 1,000 gallon rate from \$4.26 to \$4.79. As noted earlier, the \$16 bi-monthly minimum charge will remain unchanged. The estimated average resident bill based on 11,000 gallons is expected to increase \$4.24 bi-monthly (from \$50.08 to \$54.32). This number may fluctuate slightly based on seasonal water use. Even after a 12.5% rate increase on June 1, the Village is projected to have the lowest water rates and average bi-monthly bills of all surrounding communities.

The current plan remains as a cumulative 50% rate increase over a 5-year period. Each year during the budget process, staff will update Water Fund projections to make sure we are on track to fund operations and maintain a healthy reserve balance. The actual recommended rate increase may vary year to year depending on the overall health and future needs of the Water Fund.

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04 OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH AURORA MUNICIPAL CODE RE: WATER USAGE FEES

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of North Aurora, Illinois have heretofore, by ordinance established rates, fees, and service charges for water usage; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees deem a revision of the water rates, fees, and charges, and the passage of this Ordinance to be in the best interest and in pursuance of the general welfare of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Aurora, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1** Title 13 (Public Services), Chapter 13.04 (Water Service System), Section 13.04.360 (Water Usage Rates) of the North Aurora Municipal Code is hereby amended and revised in its entirety as follows:

#### **13.04.360 - Water usage rates**

- A. Consumers who use three thousand (3,000) gallons of water or less per bimonthly period shall be charged a minimum charge of sixteen dollars and no cents (\$16.00).
- B. Consumers who use in excess of three thousand (3,000) gallons of water per bimonthly period shall be charged the minimum charge of said sixteen dollars and no cents (\$16.00) plus four dollars and seventy-nine cents (\$4.79) per one thousand (1,000) gallons for all gallons used in excess of three thousand (3,000) gallons per bi-monthly period.
- **Section 2** If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, or any part thereof. The Village Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that anyone or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective
- **Section 3** This Ordinance become effective on June 1, 2024, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

RE: Oak Hill HOA Deed & Dissolution

As you know, the Village created a back-up Special Service Area for the Oak Hill Subdivision as a safety net to ensure that the detention and retention areas (and other common areas) are maintained. The Oak Hill HOA has struggled to collect dues and to find people willing to participate in board meetings and act as officers of the HOA. Because of this, the Village triggered the SSA tax a few years ago, and has been collecting those SSA taxes and maintaining the pond.

The Annexation Agreement required the establishment of the HOA with the responsibility to maintain the stormwater areas and open space lapsed after 20 years a number of years ago. The HOA has taken the action to approve a Deed to the Village of the stormwater areas (Lots 93 & 94) and to dissolve the HOA because it is not sustainable.

At a meeting in December of 2023, the Board came to an informal consensus that it would be willing to accept a deed to the stormwater control areas because of the importance of the creek that runs through the development and the pond, which is important in draining stormwater from the north through the property into the wetlands. Accepting the deed will give the Village more control over the property as public property to maintain the integrity of the drainage, and the Village can make the areas accessible park and recreation areas for the general public as assets of the Village.

No one can force the Village to take property we do not want, so we need to take formal action to approve the Deed that has been presented to us. We really have no say in the dissolution of the HOA. We can no longer require it to be maintained, now that the Annexation Agreement has lapsed. Therefore, all we need to do is approve the Resolution to accept the Deed.
